



MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

Yamaha Stryker 2011-2017 Solo and Passenger Seat

Hardware:	Solo: Studded mounting bracket 1/4"-20 flange nut 8mm x 15mm Allen screw x 2 White nylon washer x 2

Tools needed:	10mm wrench 7/16" wrench 5mm Allen wrench

Removal of Stock Seat:

1. Insert ignition key into the left side cover and turn counter-clockwise until a click is heard and solo seat is unlocked.
2. Lift the nose of the seat up and forward to release the seat from the center hook bracket.
3. Once the center of the seat is free of the bracket, pull the seat back to disengage from the rear fender bracket.
4. Remove the stock center hook bracket from the fender using a 10mm wrench. It will not be used to mount your Mustang seat.



Installation of Mustang Seat:



1. Install the supplied studded bracket to the fender. Be sure the stud is positioned toward the front of the motorcycle and is pointing up. Place the two white nylon washers between the bracket and the fender holes, and secure with the two 8mm x 15mm Allen bolts using a 5mm Allen wrench.
2. Place the Mustang passenger seat onto the fender and slide it back into the rear stock bracket. Align the front bracket with the stud on the front bracket.
3. Fasten the passenger seat's front bracket to the stud with the $\frac{1}{4}$ "-20 flange nut using a $\frac{7}{16}$ " wrench. Tighten securely, but **do not overtighten**.
4. Engage the solo seat's rear bracket under the front of the fender bracket. Lower the nose and align the seat's front latch bracket with the latch on the frame.



5. Push nose of seat down firmly until it clicks, signifying the seat is latched into position. Ensure this bracket is firmly engaged before riding.
